Alcohol Policy for Extra Curricular Activities

Guidelines for Welcome Trips, Excursions, Language Schools and Study trips in PreIB

During introductory trips, excursions and study trips in PreIB, it is not permitted to consume alcohol under any circumstances. This applies during the day, during transport and after the programme has ended at the destination. Violation of the rules may result in the student being sent home at their own expense, as well as losing the right to participate in study trips during The IB Diploma Programme.

Guidelines for Study Trips, Welcome Trips and Excursions during The IB Diploma Programme

Study trips and excursions during The IB Diploma Programme are considered teaching which takes place at another location. Attendance in the planned programme is therefore compulsory in the same way as attendance in daily teaching at the school is compulsory, and it is assumed that students will participate actively in the trip. Therefore, alcohol consumption is only permitted with the consent of the accompanying teachers, which means within the framework and during the time period determined by the teachers. No students may at any time be intoxicated (no binge drinking) to a degree that impairs their judgement, and students must be sober and attentive for the following day's programme. Under no circumstances is it permitted to drink alcohol on buses/trains/planes. This applies both to and from the destination and during transport at the destination itself. It is not permitted to consume alcohol in connection with scheduled academic activities (unless alcohol is directly included in the academic programme, such as visits to vineyards or similar). Students must always comply with the laws of the country in question, hotel rules and other rules of good conduct. Violation of the rules may result in repatriation at the student's own expense, as well as the loss of the right to participate in future study trips.

For participation in the IB Welcome Trip the same rules apply to IB1 and IB2 as apply to PreIB.
